




connectit Installation Step 1 – Welcome to the ConnectIt-MAS90 Setup Wizard




Connectit-MAS90/200 uses a standard Windows installer to set up the application on the end user's computer.

Note that **QuoteWerks** and **Microsoft .net v2.0** must be installed on the computer before running the **Connectit-MAS90/200** installation.

connectit Installation Step 2 – Select Installation details




By default, **Connectit-MAS90/200** is installed to the user's %Program Files%\Hilltops IT\Connectit-MAS90 folder.

Installed for all users on the PC or just the currently logged in user.

connectit Installation Step 3 – Confirm Installation



The Windows Installer does a final check that you want to install the **ConnectIt-MAS90 /200** application.



ConnectIt-MAS90 /200 installs to the user's computer. This usually takes just a couple of minutes (depending on the speed of the destination computer).

A progress bar indicates how far Windows is through the installation process.
